# Hostel Quick Tips Facilities & Services



## Laundry (E9 or B/F) Air-conditioning Octopus Payment ONLY

**Air-conditioning (\$1.2 / kwh)**  
Top up at credit terminal on each hostel floor for hostel room or hostel pantry.

**Washer (\$4.8 / cycle ~35 min)**  
Bring your own detergent

**Dryer (\$1.2 / 3-min)**  
Or dry your clothes in hanging area



## Hostel Service

**Fee-charging:** Door Opening  
(Seek assistance from College Office/ Hostel Reception)

**Borrowing Service (No Charge):**  
Trolley / Pesticide / Fused Converter Plugs (2-pin type A / 2-pin type C to 3-pin British plug)



## College Facilities Learning/ Amenities/ Catering

Learning Commons, Club, Sea-view Gym, Music Room, Activity Room (w/ Dart Machine) and more...



## Wired/ Wi-Fi Connection & Printing

# Hostel Quick Tips Rules & Regulations



## NO SMOKING & Dangerous Drugs (incl. e-cigarette & cannabis)

The whole CUHK campus is smoke-free (incl. e-cigarette) according to Smoking (Public Health) Ordinance, Hong Kong Law Chapter 371. It is also illegal to possess or consume dangerous drug (incl. cannabis, etomidate).



## Avoid Misuse of Fire Service System

DO NOT trigger fire service system improperly. For example the fire sprinkler head CANNOT be used as a hanger.



## Visitor Policy

Random Room Check will be carried out.

Violation may result in expulsion from hostel

**CUHK Full-time Students (incl. WYS students):**

**Same Gender** 08:00-00:00

**Opposite Gender** 10:00-23:00

**Non-CUHK Visitors:**

10:00-23:00 (Weekends & Public Holidays ONLY)



## Door Access

Bring along **your Own** CU Link Card

Residents shall bring along their own CU Link card to access College building (beyond opening hours) and facilities, and **same gender** hostel floors. Disturbance to door access system and impersonation will result in disciplinary actions.



## Overnight Visitor Tickets

Buy an overnight visitor ticket if you want to host a same-gender CUHK student visitor overnight from College Office (G03), Resident Tutors or Resident Association. Prior consent from both residents should be obtained.



## Hostel Regulations

All residents must undertake to comply with all Student Hostel Regulations.

## Anti-scam Phone/Internet/Text

## No suspicious persons

LOCK your room when you  
leave or sleep. DO NOT allow  
suspicious persons following  
you into hostel floors.

**Report to College

walk on driveway.

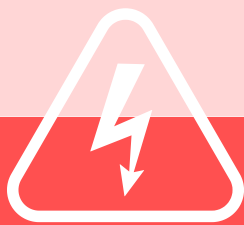
Pay attention and do not use
